Local Committee Membership . . .

Child Evangelism Fellowship® is looking for Christian men and women to serve as local committee members. This brochure gives an overview of what is involved in becoming and serving as a board member.

Mission Statement

To evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, to disciple them in the Word of God, and to establish them in a local church for Christian living.

The board provides accountability and direction to the local ministry. It is made up of people from Bible teaching churches of various denominations to help maintain the interdenominational spirit of the ministry and keep it true to the Statement of Faith.

Qualifications

The following requirements are necessary for a person to become a local committee member.

1. Must be saved and have assurance of salvation.
2. Must agree to abide by the Statement of Faith and sign it annually.
3. Believe that children are lost and they can be saved.
4. Be concerned about children being saved and disciplined, and willing to help reach them.
5. Willing to pray and support the CEF® program with time, money, thought and effort.
6. Active in one's own local church.
7. Maintain a good testimony in the home and community.
8. Believe that God is calling you to membership.
9. Willing to promote the ministry of CEF® in church and everyday life.

Responsibilities

1. Attend monthly meetings.
2. Attend activities and functions of CEF®.
3. Take special assignments for the promotion and work of CEF®.
4. Look for prospective teachers and helpers.
5. Look for those who will support the ministry in prayer, with their time, and finances.
6. Look for others who will serve on the local committee.
7. Prayerfully guide the direction of the local chapter.
8. Pray for the local CEF® ministries and staff.

Procedure

If you are interested in serving with the local ministry, these steps should be followed.

1. Call the Local Coordinator or one of the local committee members to discuss your desire.
2. Fill out the application and attend a meeting.
3. If you and the local committee agree, you will be asked to share your testimony with the board at the next meeting.
